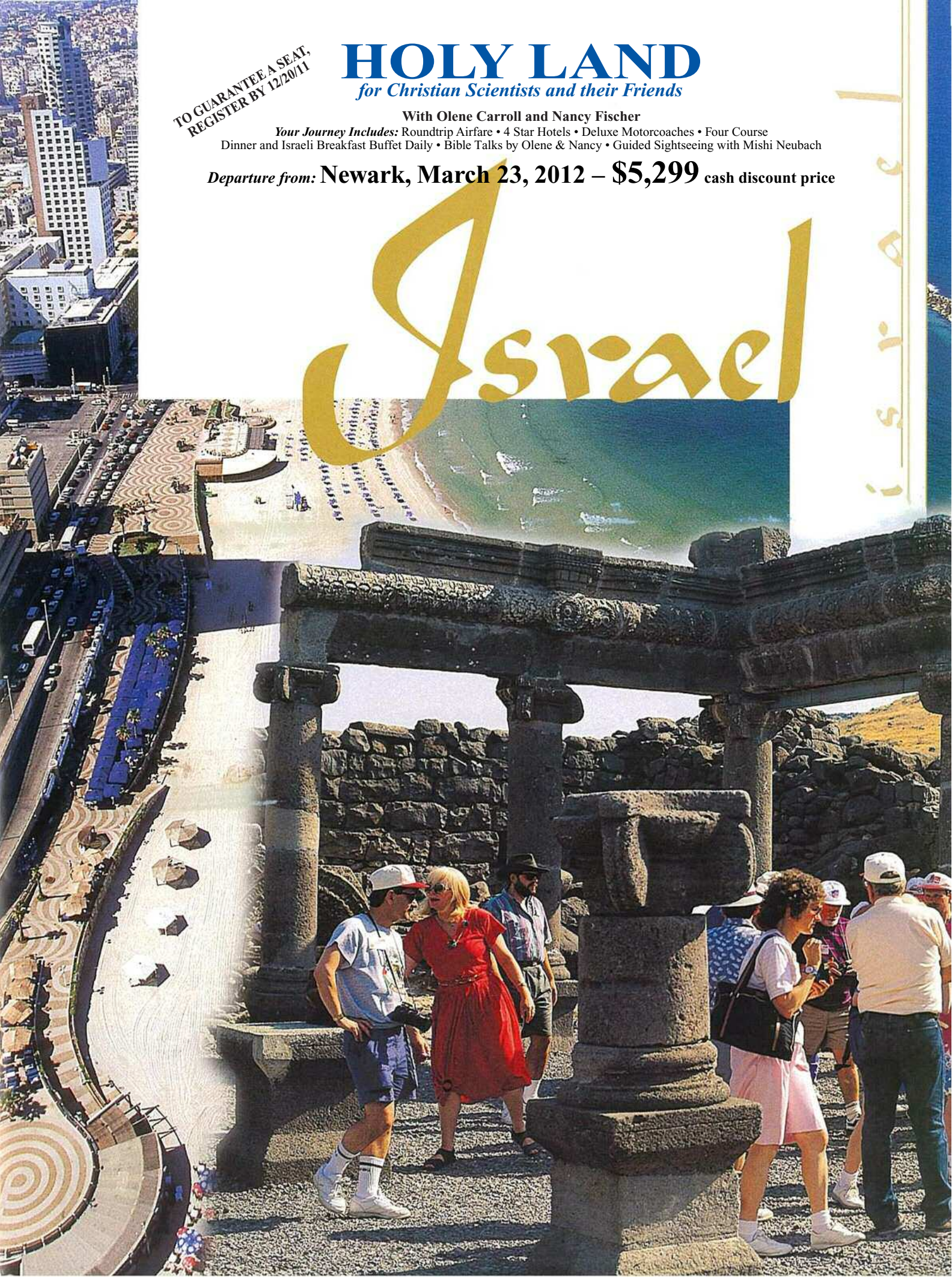

ITINERARY

FRIDAY, MARCH 23: Your pilgrimage begins as you depart the United States on your international flight.

SATURDAY, MARCH 24: You will be welcomed to the Holy Land by our representative and taken to your hotel in the **Tel Aviv** area on the shores of the **Mediterranean Sea** for dinner and overnight.

SUNDAY, MARCH 25: We'll begin our day with a visit to **Caesarea by the Sea** where Paul left for his final missionary journey and to **Mt. Carmel** where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal. Next we'll travel to the site of King Solomon's "Chariot City" of **Megiddo**, atop the ruins of 20 ancient cities overlooking the great battlefield of ancient Palestine. From there we'll proceed to **Nazareth**, where Jesus spent his childhood years. We'll drive through **Cana**, where Jesus turned the water into wine - his first recorded demonstration of God's power. Finally, we'll go to our hotel in **Tiberias** on the shores of the **Sea of Galilee** for dinner and overnight.

MONDAY, MARCH 26: Today we'll begin with a **Boat Ride** across the Sea of Galilee where we'll stop for **reflection**. We'll then visit **Kibbutz Ginosar** where we'll see the **ancient boat** from the time of Jesus. From there we'll continue to the archaeological site of **Beit Saida**, the home of three of the disciples, and the place where Nancy & Olene spent time working on the excavation. We'll continue with a view of the **Road to Damascus** where Paul had his conversion experience. Next we'll visit **Caesarea Philippi** at the foot of **Mount Hermon**, the ancient Roman city where Peter first confessed Jesus as the Son of the living God. From there we'll return to our hotel in Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

TUESDAY, MARCH 27: Today we'll begin our day with a visit to the hills above the Sea where we find the **Mount of Beatitudes**. It was here that Jesus gave us the beautiful words from Matthew's gospel. We'll continue to **Capernaum**, the area where Jesus spent most of his ministry. From there we'll drive to see the Roman ruins at **Beit She'an**, which was continuously inhabited for 5000 years. We'll proceed to **Gideon's Spring** at the foothills of the Gilboa Mountains. This is the place where Gideon defeated the Midianites in the famous battle. We'll end our day with a visit to the **Jordan River** before we return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

WEDNESDAY, MARCH 28: We'll awaken early to celebrate the **Morning Meal** on the Galilean shore. We'll then drive to the **Sheikh Hussein Bridge** where we'll cross the border to Jordan. After stopping for a brief visit at the **Jabbock River** where Jacob wrestled with the angel, we'll continue to **Amman** for a tour of the highlights of this beautiful city before we check into our hotel for overnight.

THURSDAY, MARCH 29: We'll begin our day today with a visit to the Christian village of **Madaba** to see the ancient mosaic map of the Holy Land. Next, we'll visit **Mount Nebo** from which Moses viewed the Promised Land. We'll stop to view **Machaerus**, a mountain-top fortress palace overlooking the Dead Sea, where John the Baptist was imprisoned and beheaded. We'll drive along the **King's Highway** where we'll view **Shawback's Crusader Castle** on our way to **Petra** for dinner and overnight.



FRIDAY, MARCH 30: Today we'll explore the Rose Red City of **Petra**. This 2000-year old city was carved by the Nabataens out of the native rock. It has been protected through the centuries by a ring of mountains surrounding the area. We will take a brief horse ride to the dramatic "**Ciq**" or canyon where we'll then walk to the famous **Treasury**, carved in pink stone. We will continue past the **Roman Theatre**, the **Corinthian Tomb** and the **Palace Tomb** to the **Roman Road**. Afterward, we'll travel from Petra to the port city of **Aqaba** for dinner and overnight.

SATURDAY, MARCH 31: Today we'll cross the border back to Israel. We'll visit a well-known **Bird Sanctuary** in Eilat where we'll observe the great work they're doing in that strategic migration route between Africa and Europe. After our visit there we'll travel through the **Negev Desert** to **Jerusalem**. We'll begin our visit there with a stop on the **Mount of Olives** where we'll see a breathtaking **Panoramic View** of the Old City of Jerusalem. We'll walk part of the **Palm Sunday Road** to the **Garden of Gethsemane**, where Jesus went with the disciples on the final night before his crucifixion. After visiting the garden, with its **ancient olive trees**, we'll go to the **Shepherds' Field** in **Bethlehem**, commemorating the birth of Jesus. We'll check in to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

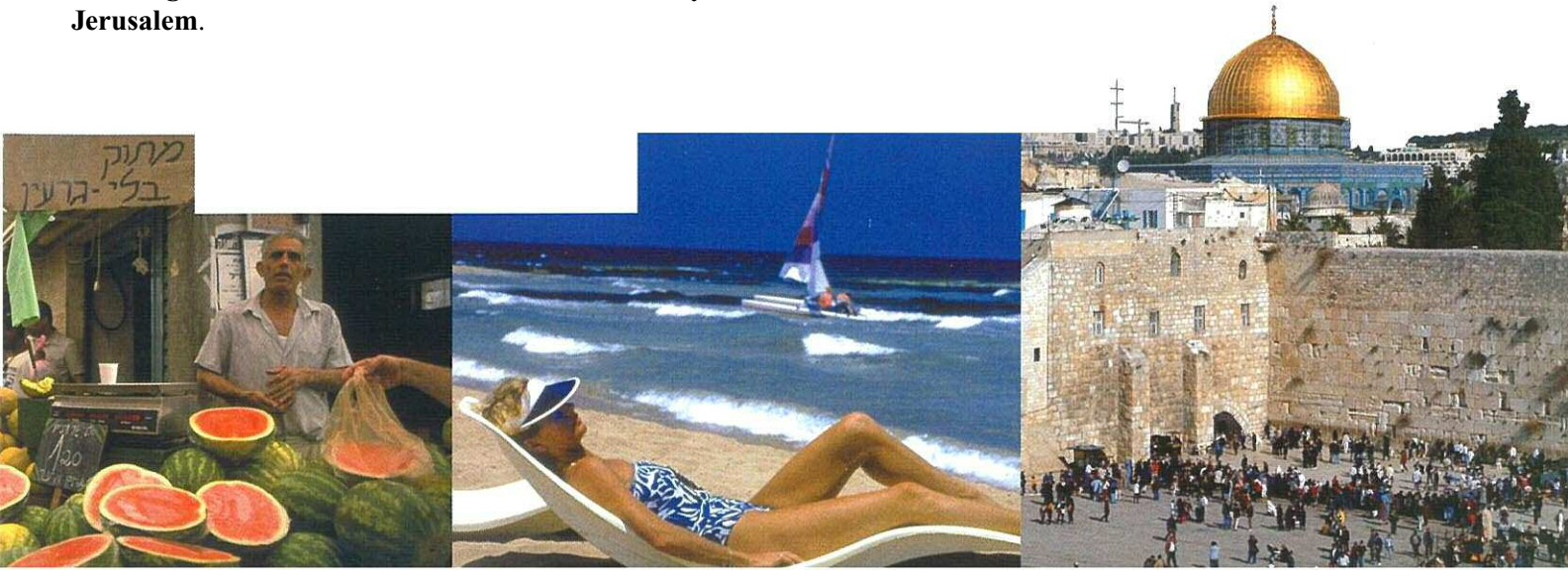
SUNDAY, APRIL 1: Today we will begin with a visit to the **Temple Mount** where we'll view the **Dome of the Rock mosque**. From there we'll proceed to the **Western Wall**, the place most precious for Jews around the world. We'll visit the **Roman Cardo** in the **Jewish Quarter** and have some time for shopping there. We'll continue to the **Israel Museum** where we'll see the **Dead Sea Scrolls** as well as the **Model of First Century Jerusalem**. We'll finish the day with an opportunity to shop for Holy Land souvenirs before returning to our hotel for dinner and overnight. After dinner at the hotel we'll go to the **Sound and Light Show** at the walls of the **Old City of Jerusalem**.

MONDAY, APRIL 2: This morning we'll travel through the **Judean Desert** to **Masada**, the amazing mountain-top fortress built by Herod, and site of final battle in the Jewish Rebellion against the Romans. We'll drive along the shores of the **Dead Sea**, passing **En Gedi** on our way. After our visit there, we'll go to **Qumran** where the **Dead Sea Scrolls** were discovered. We'll continue with a stop at the **Dead Sea** for some "floating" on the water. On our drive up to Jerusalem we'll pass **Jericho**, the world's oldest inhabited city. It was there that Elisha healed the waters of that city. Along the way we'll view the **Mount of Temptation**, as well as part of the ancient **Roman Road**. We'll return to our hotel for dinner. After dinner at the hotel we'll have a **testimony meeting** with the local Christian Scientists.

TUESDAY, APRIL 3: Today we'll begin our day with a visit at the **Pool of Bethesda** where Jesus healed the crippled man. We'll sing a hymn in the **Church of St. Anne**. We'll visit the **Church of the Holy Sepulchre** and walk through the fascinating **Arab market**. We'll continue to **Mount Zion** where we'll see the **Upper Room** and **King David's Tomb** as well as the **House of Caiaphas** where Jesus was imprisoned for a night. We'll return to our hotel for our **Farewell Dinner & overnight**.

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 4: We'll begin our final day with a very special visit to the **Garden Tomb** and some time for reflection. We'll say farewell to Jerusalem and drive from there to **Emmaus**. It was on the road to this village that the disciples met Jesus after the resurrection. We'll drive to **Jaffa (Joppa)** where Jonah left on his voyage and where Peter raised Tabitha. We'll stop in **Jaffa** for a visit and dinner before going to the airport to check in for our flight back to the USA.

THURSDAY, APRIL 5: You'll arrive home full of new insights and understandings about the land of the Bible.

PROGRAM CONDITIONS

INCLUDED IN PRICE OF STANDARD PROGRAM: Round trip airfare, transfers with group to/from airport; shared double room in first class hotel; two meals daily; English speaking guide; transfer to and entrance fees for sites to be visited.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE: Tips of \$230 per person to be collected and distributed by tour operator; Single room charges (see below); Additions or changes to the standard program (see below); individual transfers; travel insurance; laundry, coffee and drinks; excess baggage and items of a personal nature. Additional charge to pay by credit card is \$218 for double occupancy and \$258 for single occupancy.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE: Deposit of \$500 due with registration. Final payment is due December 20, 2011.

SINGLE ROOMS: When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. Single room supplement is \$1000.

ROOMMATES: You will be charged for a single room if you do not have a roommate and/or Omega Travel cannot match you with one.

MEALS: Buffet breakfast and set menu dinner daily. All other meals are "on your own".

LUGGAGE: Limit of one suitcase and one carry-on per person, not to exceed 50 pounds or 62 inches total.

TRANSFERS: Transport between airport, hotel and piers is included in the standard program. However, those who request changes from standard program are responsible for their own transfers even when coinciding with group transfers.

CHANGES FROM STANDARD PROGRAM: Changes must be requested and approved in writing by Omega Travel. A minimum of \$150 will be charged and transfers to/from airports, etc. are not included.

AIRLINE TICKETS: Printed 45 days prior to departure, tickets cannot be changed or refunded thereafter. Air transportation to/from your European destination will be jet economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amenable tickets for groups of 10 or more passengers flying together for entire itinerary.

FLIGHT TIMES: Subject to change by airlines without advance notice. Omega Travel is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays.

ITINERARY LENGTH: Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, Omega Travel reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly and, whenever possible, you will be notified in writing. If changes necessitate extra overnights, there will be additional charges.

CANCELLATION FEES: From the day of registration to 120 days prior to departure the \$100 non-refundable registration fee is the only charge. Thereafter, the following charges apply: 119-90 days: \$500; 89-60 days: 50% of total cost; 59-45 days: 75% of total cost; 44 days to day of departure: 100% of total cost. All refund claims must be received in writing.

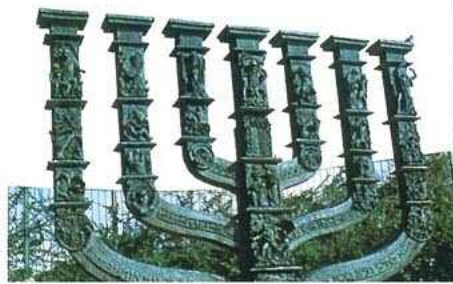
All prices, itineraries and schedules are subject to regulations and changes thereof by acts of Government, International Agreement and Airline tariff adjustments, rules and regulations.
