PROGRAM CONDITIONS

INCLUDED IN PRICE OF STANDARD PROGRAM: Round trip airfare, transfers with group to/from airport; shared double room in first-class hotel; meals as outlined; English speaking guide; transfer to and entrance fees for sites to be visited.

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE: Tips of \$250 to be collected on first day of tour and distributed by tour operator; Single room charges (see below); Additions or changes to the standard program (see below); individual transfers; travel insurance; laundry, coffee and drinks; excess baggage and items of a personal nature. Additional charge of \$220 for double occupancy and \$248 for single to pay by credit card.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE: A deposit of \$750 is due with registration. Final payment is due APRIL 1, 2010.

SINGLE ROOMS: When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. Single room supplement is \$700.

ROOMMATES: You will be charged for a single room if you do not have a roommate and/or Omega Travel cannot match you with one.

MEALS: Buffet breakfast and set menu dinner daily. All other meals are "on your own".

LUGGAGE: Limit of one suitcase and one carry-on per person, not to exceed 50 pounds or 62 inches total.

TRANSFERS: Transport between airport, hotel and piers is included in the standard program. However, those who request changes from standard program are responsible for their own transfers even when coinciding with group transfers.

CHANGES FROM STANDARD PROGRAM: Changes must be requested and approved in writing by Omega Travel. A minimum of \$150 will be charged and transfers to/from airports, etc. are not included.

AIRLINE TICKETS: Printed 45 days prior to departure, tickets cannot be changed or refunded thereafter. Air transportation to/from your European destination will be jet economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amenable tickets for groups of 10 or more passengers flying together for entire itinerary.

FLIGHT TIMES: Subject to change by airlines without advance notice. Omega Travel is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays.

ITINERARY LENGTH: Because airlines often change flight schedules after brochures are printed, Omega Travel reserves the right to shorten or lengthen the itinerary accordingly and, whenever possible, you will be notified in writing. If changes necessitate extra overnights, there will be additional charges.

CANCELLATION FEES: From the day of registration to Dec 15: \$500; Dec 15 to April 15: \$2000; After April 15: 100% of total cost. All refund claims must be received in writing.

JULY 12 – Your adventure begins as you board your international flight from Houston to **Berlin**.

JULY 13 – Arrival in **Berlin**. Meet your tour director who will guide you to your waiting motor coach. On the way to your hotel enjoy a **city orientation tour**. Check into your hotel. Tonight enjoy your welcome dinner and a short orientation of the days ahead with your tour director. (D)



JULY 14 – This morning time for exploring **Berlin** on your own or for shopping. Early afternoon departure to **Wittenberg** where you will meet your local guide. Your walking tour of Wittenberg includes the visit of the **Schlosskirche** (castle church). **Luther** nailed his 95 theses on 31 October 1517. We will also visit the **Church of St. Mary's** where Luther used to preach as well as the **house of Luther**. (B,D)

JULY 15 – Your first stop this morning is **Erfurt**. Visit **St. Mary's Cathedral** and enjoy an **organ recital** at the **Preacher Church**. After that continue to the **Augustinian Monastery** which Luther entered to become a monk in 1505. Late afternoon departure

to **Eisenach**, birth town of Johann Sebastian Bach. (B,D)

JULY 16 – Another exciting day starts with the visit of **Wartburg castle**, one of the highpoints of this trip. Luther fled here when persecuted. He lived here for 10 months and translated the entire New Testament into the German language After some time on your own we will continue to **Rüdesheim**, a lively wine village along the romantic **Rhine River**. (B,D)

JULY 17 – This morning, after breakfast, board your white steamer for a **Rhine Cruise**. See charming vineyards, castles and medieval villages floating by. The afternoon is reserved for an excursion to **Mainz** to visit the **Gutenberg Museum**. (B,D)

JULY 18 – First stop this morning is **Worms** to see the sites of the **Worms Debates** and the **Reformation Monument**. On to **Heidelberg**, site of Germany's oldest university. Time to explore this charming town on your own. Continue south into the **Black Forest**. Overnight in the area of **Triberg**. (B,D)

JULY 19 – Drive through the scenic roads of the **Black Forest** to the scenery of the **Bavarian Alps**. Late arrival in **Oberammergau**. (B,D)

JULY 20 – The morning is free to explore **Oberammergau**. You might want to do some shopping or visit the local museum. After lunch experience history first hand and attend the **Passion Play**, performed only every 10 years. (B,L,D)



JULY 21 – After breakfast check out and depart for **Switzerland**, this gem of a country. Stop at Switzerland's capital of **Bern** before you enter the magnificent scenery of the **Swiss Alps**. Overnight in the car-free mountain village of **Wengen**. (B,D)

JULY 22 – Whole day to enjoy the unforgettable mountain scenery. You might want to take one of the **cogwheel trains** or **cable cars** for an excursion to the alps. (B,D)



JULY 23 – Morning departure to **Luzern**. Time on your own to walk across the famous wooden bridge or to explore the historic part of this well known town. Depart for **Zürich**. (B,D)

JULY 24 – Morning walking tour with a local guide through the old historic part of **Zürich**. Your tour includes a visit to the **Grossmünster**, where the Swiss Reformation was started by **Ulrich Zwingli**. We will also visit the **Fraumünster** famous for the stained windows of the 12 apostles by Marc Chagall. At lunch time we will board a steam ship for a lunch cruise on **Lake Zürich**. (B,L)

JULY 25 – Transfer to **Kloten** airport for your return flight to the USA. (B)
