

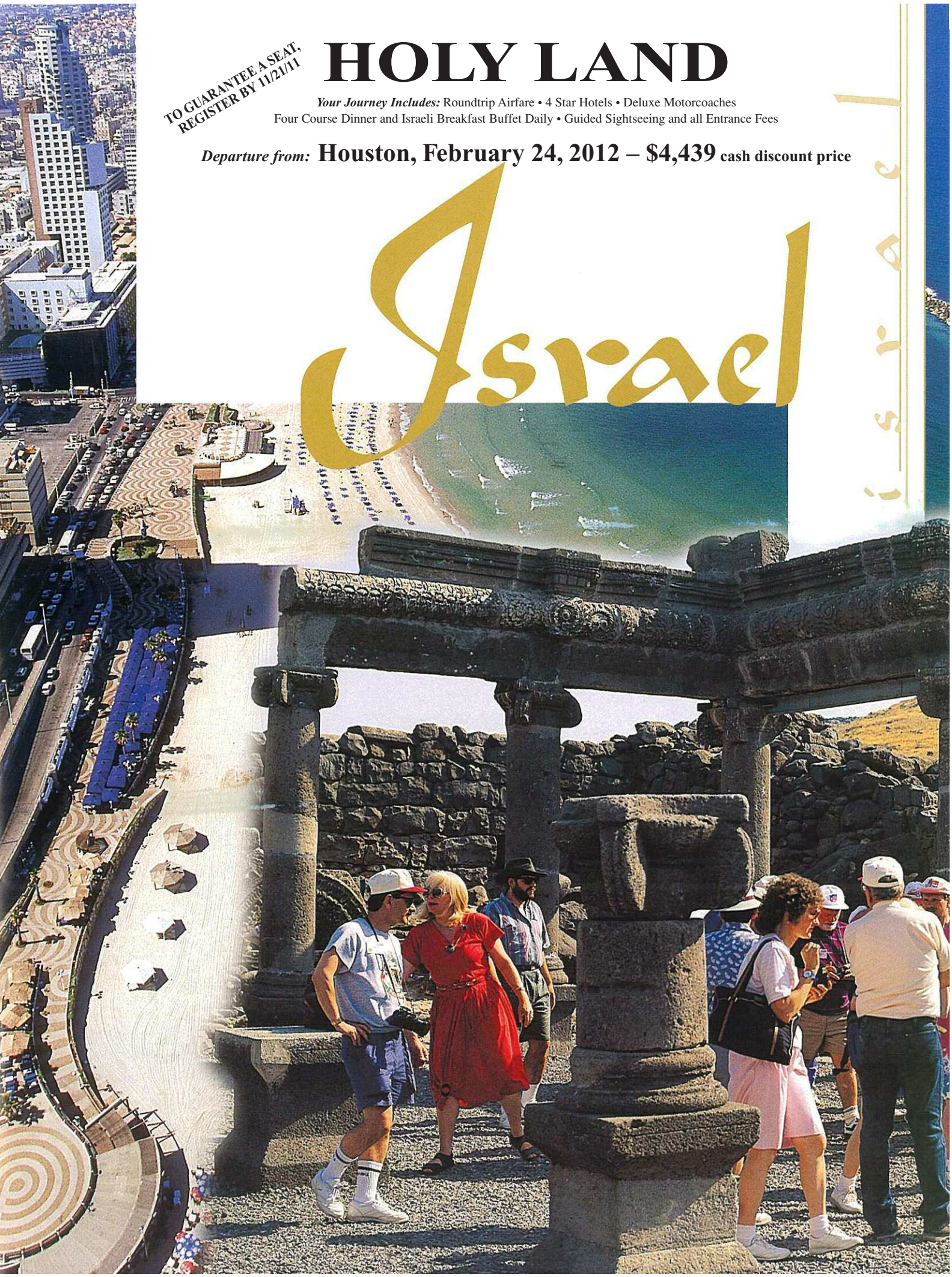

## ITINERARY

**FEBRUARY 24** – Your pilgrimage begins as you depart the United States on your international flight.

**FEBRUARY 25** – You will have a morning flight to the Holy Land where you will be welcomed by our representative and taken to your hotel in the **Tel Aviv** area. There you will have dinner and overnight.

**FEBRUARY 26** – We'll begin our day with a drive along the coast of the **Mediterranean Sea** to **Caesarea by the Sea**. There we'll see the Roman ruins of the great Theater and Aqueduct, as well as the Crusader city later built on this site. This is the place where Paul left for his final missionary journey. We'll continue to **Mt. Carmel** where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal. Next we'll travel to **Megiddo**, also known as **Armageddon**. This is the place where Christians believe the final great battle of the world will be fought. We'll travel to **Nazareth** where the angel appeared to Mary to announce that she would be the mother of God's Son. This is also the place where Jesus spent his childhood years. From there we'll travel through **Cana** where Jesus performed his first miracle as we proceed to **Tiberias** for dinner and overnight.

**FEBRUARY 27** – Today we'll begin with a **Boat Ride** across the **Sea of Galilee** where we'll stop for a devotional service. We'll then visit **Kibbutz Ginosar** where we'll see the **ancient boat** from the time of Jesus. We'll travel on to **Tabgha**, the site of the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves and fishes.

From there we'll continue our tour with a visit to the hills above the sea where we find the **Mount of Beatitudes**. It was here that Jesus gave us the beautiful words from Matthew's gospel. We'll finish our day at **Capernaum**, the area where Jesus spent most of his ministry, and then return to our hotel in Tiberias for dinner and overnight.

**FEBRUARY 28** – Today we'll begin with a drive to see the Roman ruins at **Beit She'an**, which was continuously inhabited for 5000 years. From there we'll continue to visit **Zippori**, not far from Nazareth and a center of learning during the time of Jesus. We'll see the beautiful mosaics and get a feel for the area where Jesus grew up. We'll end our day with a **renewal of our baptism vows** at the **Jordan River** before we return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

**FEBRUARY 29** – We'll drive to the **Sheikh Hussein Bridge** where we'll cross the border to Jordan. We'll visit the **baptism site of Jesus** in the desert area of Jordan. From there we'll continue to **Amman** for a tour of the highlights of this beautiful city before we check into our hotel for overnight

**MARCH 1** – We'll begin our day today with a visit to the Christian village of **Madaba** to see the ancient mosaic map of the Holy Land. Next, we'll visit **Mount Nebo** from which Moses viewed the Promised Land. We'll drive along the **King's Highway** where we'll view **Shawback's Crusader Castle** on our way to **Petra** for dinner and overnight.

**MARCH 2** – Today we'll explore the Rose Red City of **Petra**. This 2000-year old city was carved by the Nabataens out of the native rock. It has been protected through the centuries by a ring of mountains surrounding the area. We will take a brief



horse ride to the dramatic “**Ciq**” or canyon where we’ll then walk to the famous **Treasury**, carved in pink stone. We will continue past the **Roman Theatre**, the **Corinthian Tomb** and the **Palace Tomb** to the **Roman Road**. Afterward, we’ll travel from Petra to the port city of **Aqaba** for dinner and overnight.

**MARCH 3** – This morning we’ll drive through the desert to **Masada**, the amazing mountain-top fortress built by Herod and site of the final battle in the Jewish Rebellion against the Romans. After our visit there we’ll continue along the **Dead Sea**, passing the springs of **Ein Gedi** on our way to visit **Qumran** where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. We’ll finish our day with a swim at the **Dead Sea** before a drive through the Judean wilderness on our way up to **Jerusalem** for dinner and overnight.

**MARCH 4** – Today’s tour begins with a visit to the **Mount of Olives** where we’ll see a breathtaking **Panoramic View** of the **Old City of Jerusalem**. We’ll walk a part of the **Palm Sunday Road** to the **Garden of Gethsemane** where Jesus went with the disciples on the final night before his crucifixion. There we’ll visit the **Church of All Nations** and the garden with its ancient olive trees. Next we’ll go to **Mount Zion** where we’ll see the **Upper Room** and **King David’s Tomb**. From there we’ll go to the **House of Caiaphas** where Jesus was imprisoned for a night. Our last visit today will be to **Bethlehem** where we’ll visit the **Nativity Church** and the **grotto** which is believed to be the birthplace of Jesus. Finally we’ll return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

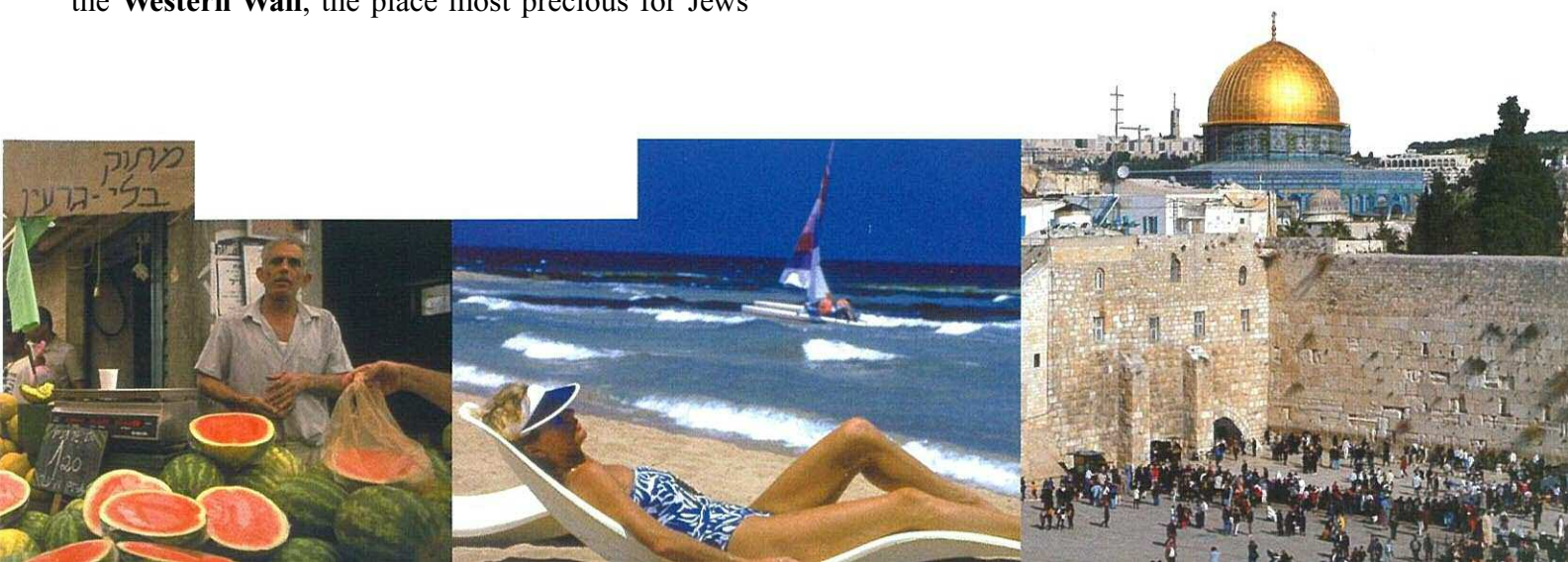
**MARCH 5** – Our day will begin today with a visit to the **Western Wall**, the place most precious for Jews

around the world. We’ll proceed to the **Temple Mount** where we’ll visit the **Dome of the Rock Mosque**. We’ll continue from there to the **Pool of Bethesda** where Jesus healed the crippled man. We’ll sing a hymn in the **Church of St. Anne** before we begin our walk down the **Via Dolorosa**, following the path Jesus took to the cross. We’ll visit the **Church of the Holy Sepulcher** and walk through the fascinating Arab market. We’ll tour through the **Jewish Quarter** where we’ll see the **Roman Cardo** and other sites of interest. Finally, we’ll return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

**MARCH 6** – Today we’ll begin with a visit to the **Hadassah Hospital** where we’ll see the beautiful **Chagall windows** depicting each of the Twelve Tribes of Israel. From there we’ll go to **Yad Vashem**, the memorial to the Holocaust victims, and view the **Israeli Knesset**, seat of the Israeli Parliament and government offices. Nearby, we’ll visit the **Israel Museum** which houses the **Dead Sea Scrolls**. We’ll finish the day with a tour of the **Model of First Century Jerusalem** before returning to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

**MARCH 7** – Today we’ll finish our visit in the Holy Land with a very special service of **Communion at the Garden Tomb**. After communion, we’ll return to the hotel to freshen for our **Farewell Dinner** and overnight.

**MARCH 8** – This morning after breakfast we’ll proceed to the airport for our return flight to the USA. We will return to the USA filled with new insights and understandings about the life and land of Jesus.

#### PROGRAM CONDITIONS

**INCLUDED IN PRICE OF STANDARD PROGRAM:** Round trip airfare, transfers with group to/from airport; shared double room in moderate hotel; two meals daily; English speaking guide; transfer to and entrance fees for sites to be visited.  
**NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE:** Tips of \$215 to be collected and distributed by tour operator; Single room charges (see below); Additions or changes to the standard program (see below); individual transfers; travel insurance; laundry, coffee and drinks; excess baggage and items of a personal nature; **any increase in taxes and fees that may occur between the printing of this brochure and issuing of airline tickets.** Price is based on the exchange rate at the time of printing and may be subject to change. Additional charge of \$178 for double occupancy and \$222 for single occupancy to pay by credit card.

**PAYMENT SCHEDULE:** Deposit of \$500 due with registration. Final payment is due November 21, 2011.

**SINGLE ROOMS:** When available, single rooms are often smaller than doubles. Single room supplement is \$1100.

**ROOMMATES:** You will be charged for a single room if you do not have a roommate and/or Omega Travel cannot match you with one.

**MEALS:** Buffet breakfast and set menu dinner daily. All other meals are "on your own".

**LUGGAGE:** Limit of one suitcase and one carry-on per person, not to exceed 50 pounds or 62 inches total.

**TRANSFERS:** Transport between airport, hotel and piers is included in the standard program. However, those who request changes from standard program are responsible for their own transfers even when coinciding with group transfers.

**CHANGES FROM STANDARD PROGRAM:** Changes must be requested and approved in writing by Omega Travel. A minimum of \$150 will be charged and transfers to/from airports, etc. are not included.

**AIRLINE TICKETS:** Printed 45 days prior to departure, tickets cannot be changed or refunded thereafter. Air transportation to/from your European destination will be jet economy class aboard IATA and ARC carriers utilizing APEX or SUPER APEX non-refundable, non-amenable tickets for groups of 10 or more passengers flying together for entire itinerary.

**FLIGHT TIMES:** Subject to change by airlines without advance notice. Omega Travel is not responsible for such changes or delays and does not reimburse expenses resulting from such delays.
