ALL PRICES, ITINERARIES AND SCHEDULES ARE SUBJECT TO REGULATIONS AND CHANGES THEREOF BY ACTS OF GOVERNMENT, INTERNATIONAL AGREEMENT AND AIRLINE TARIFF ADJUSTMENTS, RULES AND REGULATIONS.

IN THE EVENT OF RESCHEDULING OF THE TOUR DUE TO UNFORESEEN CIRCUMSTANCES, THE CANCELLATION AND REFUND CLAUSE WILL APPLY. OMEGA TRAVEL MAY DECLINE TO ACCEPT OR RETAIN ANY INDIVIDUAL AS A PARTICIPANT ON THE TOUR AT ANY TIME. IF ANY TOUR PARTICIPANT LEAVES OR IS REMOVED FROM THE TOUR, OMEGA TRAVEL IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY RELATED EXPENSES. EXCEPT FOR THE WILLFUL NEGLIGENCE OF ITS DIRECT EMPLOYEES, THE TOUR OPERATOR ASSUMES NO LIABILITY OR RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY INJURIES, INCONVENIENCES, ILLNESS, IRREGULARITY OR INCIDENTAL DAMAGES OCCASIONED BY CIRCUMSTANCES BEYOND THE CONTROL OF TOUR OPERATOR, OR BY ANY PERSON OR REASON WHATSOEVER, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO EVENTS SUCH AS STRIKES, REVOLTS, WARS, NATURAL DISASTERS, CLOSURES OF AIRPORTS OR HOTELS, DEFAULT OR OMISSION OF ANY COMMON OR PRIVATE CARRIER OR THE DEFAULT, NEGLIGENCE OR OMISSION OF AND BY ANY THIRD PARTY PROVIDING SERVICES OR FACILITIES RELATED TO OR INCLUDED IN THIS TOUR OR ANY PART THEREOF, OR IN ARRANGING FOR THE SAME, OR THE ACTS OR OMISSIONS OF THE TOUR HOST.

THE COMMERCIAL CARRIERS ARE NOT TO BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ACT, OMISSION OR EVENT DURING THE TIME THE PASSENGERS ARE NOT ON BOARD COMMERCIAL CARRIERS. NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE: THIS OF \$165 TO BE COLLECTED ON FIRST DAY OF TOUR AND DISTRIBUTED BY TOUR OPERATOR; SINGLE ROOM CHARGES (SEE BELOW); ADDITIONS OR CHANGES TO THE STANDARD PROGRAM (SEE BELOW); INDIVIDUAL TRANSFERS; TRAVEL INSURANCE; LAUNDRY; COFFEE AND DRINKS; EXCESS BAGGAGE AND ITEMS OF A PERSONAL NATURE. AIR TRANSPORTATION TO/FROM YOUR EUROPEAN DESTINATION WILL BE JET ECONOMY CLASS ABOARD JATA AND ARC CARRIERS UTILIZING APEX OR SUPER APEX NON-REFUNDABLE, NON-AMENABLE TICKETS FOR GROUPS OF 10 OR MORE PASSENGERS FLYING TOGETHER FOR ENTIRE ITINERARY.

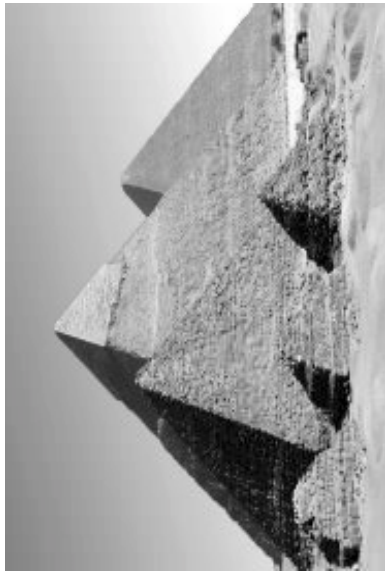

ITINERARY

Monday, May 24: You will board your international flight at New York's **JFK airport** to begin your adventure to **Turkey** and **Egypt**. You will have dinner on the flight. **(D)**

Tuesday, May 25: After breakfast on the flight, you will arrive in Istanbul and change planes for your flight to Izmir. You will meet your guide upon arrival in Izmir, which is ancient **Symrna**, one of the 7 churches of the Revelation. You will go to the **Church of St. Polycarp** for a visit before going to your hotel in Kusadasi for dinner and overnight. **(B,D)**

Wednesday, May 26: After breakfast at the hotel, you will depart for a visit to **Ephesus**, another of the churches of the Revelation where Paul lived and taught for 3 years. You will see the amazing ruins of this great city: the **theater**, the **library**, and the **Temple of Hadrian**. After your visit in Ephesus you will drive to **Collosea** on the foothills of **Mount Honaz**. You will continue to **Laodicea**, one of the 7 churches of Revelation and **Hierapolis** where you will visit the **monuments**, **thermal baths** and the **theater** with its well preserved **stage** and **Temple of Apollo**. You will then go to your hotel in **Pamukkale** for dinner and overnight. **(B,D)**

Thursday, May 27: After breakfast you will leave for **Bergama**, the site of ancient **Pergamon**, another of Revelation's churches. You will visit the **acropolis** and see the **theater**, the **Temple of Athena**, and other ruins of former civilizations. You will then go to

the beautiful resort town of **Ayalik** for dinner and overnight. **(B,D)**

Friday, May 28: After breakfast you will travel to **Troy**, the setting of Homer's *Iliad* and *Odyssey*. After your visit there you will cross the **Dardanelles** and drive along the northern route to Istanbul. Once you arrive in **Istanbul**, you will go to the **Grand Bazaar** where you will have time for shopping. You will then check into your hotel for dinner and overnight. **(B,D)**

Saturday, May 29: After breakfast today you will have a full day of sightseeing in **Istanbul**. This will include a visit to the impressive structure known as **Hagia (Saint) Sophia**. It was built as a church, converted to the principal mosque in Istanbul, and now a museum. From there you will go to the **Blue Mosque**, the primary mosque of Istanbul today and one of the finest creations of Turkish architecture. Next you will visit the **Topkapi Palace**, built as a summer palace by Mehmet II and enlarged by Sultan Suleiman the Magnificent to be used as his primary residence. You will also see the **Treasury** of the palace which houses the gold and jewels of the Sultans. You will go to the **Underground Cisterns** before heading to the airport for your flight to **Cairo**. You will have dinner on the flight. Upon arrival you will check in to your hotel in Cairo. **(B,D)**

Sunday, May 30: After breakfast you will begin your visit to Cairo by exploring the **Pyramids** and **Sphinx of Giza**. These are one of the best preserved of all of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World. This afternoon you will see the treasures in the **Egyptian Museum**, many of which date back over 3000

years. You will then return to your hotel for dinner and overnight. Option: dinner cruise on the Nile. Price TBA. **(B,D)**

Monday, May 31: After breakfast you will go to the airport for your flight to Luxor. You will visit the **East Bank** and the magnificent **Temples of Karnak** and **Luxor**, which at one time were decorated with gold, silver, alabaster and marble. Many of the ruins you will find here are in nearly perfect condition. You will then go to your hotel in Luxor for dinner and overnight. **(B,D)**

Tuesday, June 1: After breakfast you will go to visit the **West Bank**, the **Valley of the Kings** which includes the tomb of the boy-king Tutankhamen, and the **Valley of the Queens**. You will also see the spectacular **Temple of Queen Hatshepsut**. You will then go to the airport for your flight back to Cairo. You will check into the hotel for dinner and a brief rest. You will then go to the airport for your early morning flight to Istanbul. **(B,D)**

Wednesday, June 2: You will have a very early check-in to your hotel and time to rest and refresh yourself after your flight. You will have a relaxing afternoon **boat tour on the Bosphorus** where you'll get a completely different perspective of Istanbul. You'll then go to your hotel for your **Farewell Dinner** and overnight. **(B,D)**

Thursday, June 3: After breakfast you will transfer to the airport for your return flight to New York's JFK airport. Lunch and snacks will be served on the flight. **(B,L)**
